


The five most well-known classes of vertebrates (animals with backbones) are mammals, birds, fish, reptiles, amphibians. There are also a lot of animals without backbones. These are called invertebrates. Two of the most commonly known classes are arachnids (spiders) and insects.







Grade 4 created mind-maps to show their understanding and presented their mind-map posters shown below.














In Module 3 "Inventions", the Grade 5 students learn to become an inventor and use the creative thinking skills to design and create their own inventions. In January, students attended an interesting SCAMPER workshop and learned to use the inventing techniques "SCAMPER" (<u>Substitute</u>, <u>Combine</u>, <u>A</u>dapt, <u>Magnify</u>/<u>Minify</u>, <u>Put to other uses</u>, <u>Eliminate</u>, <u>Rearrange</u>/<u>Reverse</u>). Now it's time to put what they have learned in action and come up with an original idea to make inventions using SCAMPER. In addition, students will introduce their inventions and explain its features and operations in the explanatory writing.





The Sixth Graders are now immersed in the "Wonders of Science" for their 2^{nd} Module in English. They have already been introduced to the scientific method – asking a question, doing research, making a hypothesis and then testing it by designing and conducting experiments, jotting down observations, analyzing them and finally drawing conclusions.





so quickly when we are having fun! We are now drawing close to one of the most anticipated highlights of the Pui Kiu College calendar: the Annual Grade 5 Show.


We have been working so hard, making sure that our four exciting shows are in tip-top shape, just for you!
